# FY 2018 Applications and Plans

- A total of 61 Tribes and Tribal Organizations
- All applications & plans were accepted.
  - 28 were two-year plans - 15 will need NEW applications in FY 2019





# FY 2018 CSBG Allocations

- CSBG Dear Colleague FY 2018 4th CR Allocation Release, March 20, 2018.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Continuing Resolution allocation of CSBG funds to Tribes, February 7, 2018
  - Funding for January 20, 2018 - February 8, 2018
- 4<sup>th</sup> Continuing Resolution allocation of CSBG funds to Tribes, February 9, 2018
  - Funding for February 9, 2018 - March 23, 2018





## The Federal Financial Report (SF-425): Helpful Hints

- Report Type
- CSBG funds are available for obligation during the awarded fiscal year and the succeeding fiscal year.
- All obligations for the grant award must be obligated by or before September 30th of the funding period.
- All grant awards must be expended 90 days after the end of the grant funding award period.
- Any funds that have not been expended by the December 30th date must be returned to the federal government.

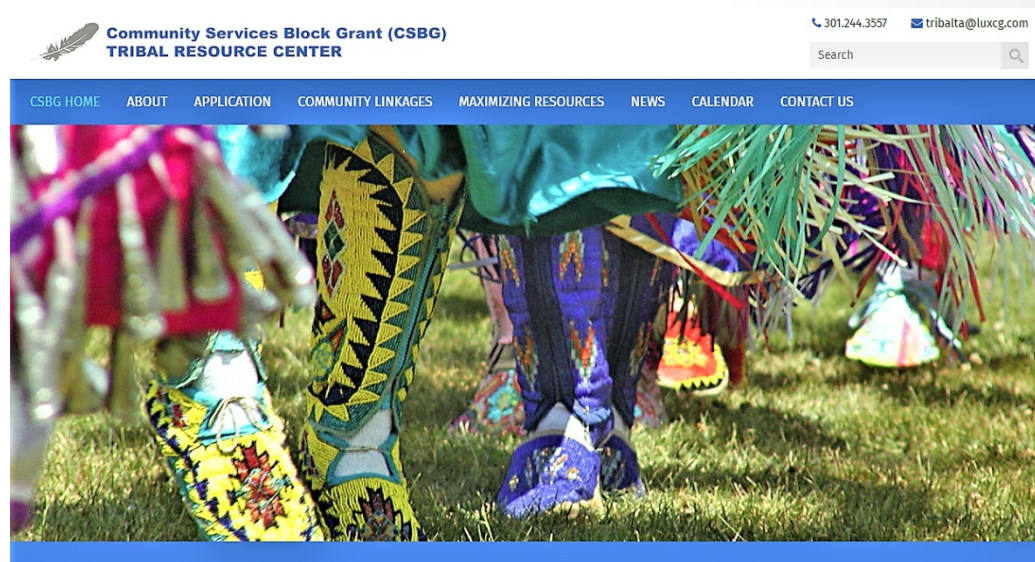


