



- An opportunity for ACF grantees & Federal staff, working with Native communities, to exchange ideas, provide feedback, and learn about how to better manage grant awards.





Deadlines for Obligating & Spending CSBG Funds

- CSBG funds are distributed on an annual fiscal year basis.
- Funds distributed for a fiscal year are available for obligation during that fiscal year and the succeeding fiscal year.
- Funds that were issued in FY2018 must be <u>obligated</u> by September 30, 2019 and <u>expended</u> by December 30, 2019.
