Funding is provided directly to State and Federally-recognized Tribes & Tribal Organizations through the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' Office of Community Services (OCS).

CSBG is a flexible, community-responsive block grant that can support a range of services and activities, including:

- Linkages & Coordination
